Swedish-Dutch Defence, Security and Aeronautics Innovation Day 30th of March 2022

Venue: the Netherlands embassy in Stockholm

On the 23rd of May 2019 the bilateral MOU between SOFF and NIDV was signed in The Hague on the Swedish-Dutch Defence, Security and Aeronautics Innovation Day. To follow-up on this fruitful day we will organize the 2022 edition in Stockholm on the 30th of March 2022.

The day serves to leverage the strong complementarity between the Dutch and Swedish defence industrial and technological systems, now that collaboration in the EU and among like-minded partners is more necessary than ever.

Through a workshop in the form of a B2B networking we will follow-up and explore the potential for new collaboration between Dutch and Swedish industry.

The Innovation day will be followed by a so called EDF Mission where incoming Dutch parties will sit with the relevant Swedish parties in order to explore the possibility of establishing consortia for specific second (or later) round EDF calls.

We like to invite you already on the 29th of March for a reception at the residence of the Dutch Ambassador, Mr. Bengt van Loosdrecht. The reception will be held from 17:00 to 19:00 and it will be a great opportunity to meet each other and expand your network.

On the 30th, the conference will start with a morning session dedicated to the complementary value of the Netherlands and Sweden, EDF in general, and the relevant calls for Sweden and the Netherlands specifically.

After the morning session, the Embassy of the Netherlands will host a lunch with a keynote speech from the Swedish Ministry of Defence: State Secretary Jan-Olof Lind.

During the afternoon session we will focus on innovation; which collaboration projects are successful? What are the future threats and how can innovation help us address these? What is the role of the knowledge institutes in comparison to the R&D departments of the companies? And last but not least, how can we intensify collaboration in the triple helices of the Netherlands and Sweden in order to form a stronger and sustainable partnership for the future?

We will close the day with a reception to wrap it up.
