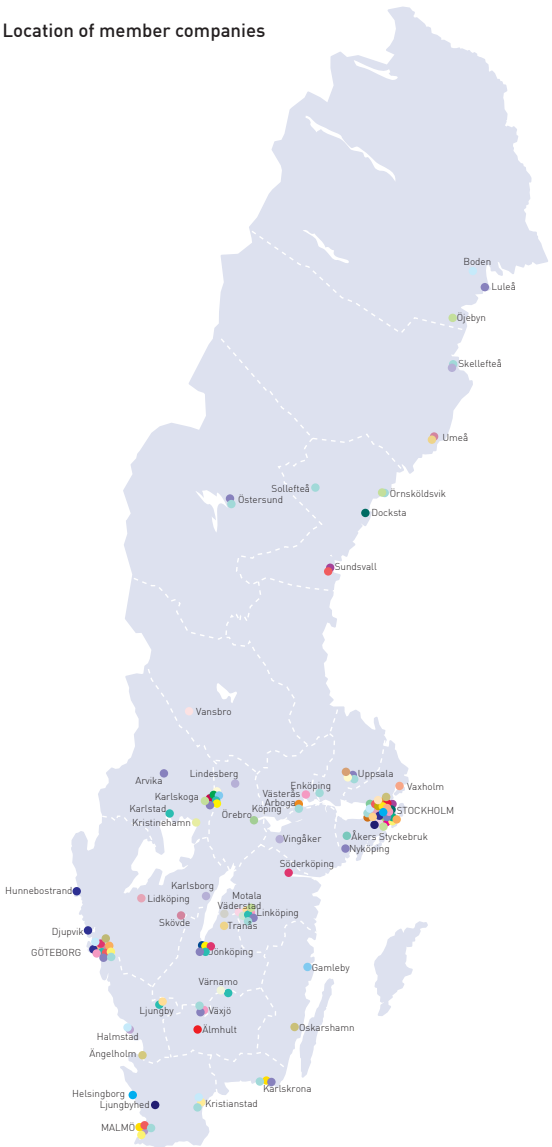

Swedish Security and Defence Industry Association

The Swedish Security and Defence Industry Association (SOFF) was founded in 1986 and is open to companies which develop and/or produce equipment and services, both military and commercial, for defence or civil security. The Association currently has approximately 60 member companies of which most are SMEs.

The mission of the Association is to assist its members in their efforts to access the domestic, European and global markets on fair and long term favorable conditions. Efforts to influence the marketplace to become more of a level playing field for all competitive industrial actors are crucial in this context. Information to the government, customers and other stakeholders, emphasizing the importance of a national industry for security of defence acting under comparable conditions on an international arena is another important task.

The Association represents the Swedish security and defence industry in ASD (AeroSpace and Defence Industries Association of Europe), NIAG/PfP (NATO Industrial Advisory Group/Partnership for Peace) and is the appointed Swedish National Defence Industry Association (NDIA) towards the EU (European Defence Agency, EU Commission) and in the Nordic context (NORDEFECO), this in addition to closely co-operating with defence industry organisations and associations in several countries.

The Association maintains a close dialogue and collaborates extensively with the Swedish government as well as supporting agencies such as the Swedish Armed Forces, Swedish Defence Materiel Administration (FMV), Swedish Defence & Security Export Agency (FXM) and the Swedish Defence Research Agency (FOI).

SOFF support the member companies through:

Advocacy: SOFF represents the interest of the industry; nationally and internationally to Government, Armed Forces, procurement authorities, NGO, ASD and other organisations.

Networking: SOFF internal process offers great possibilities for networking. SOFF also arranges B2B meetings, and exhibitions for networking outside the Association with other NDIA member companies and others.

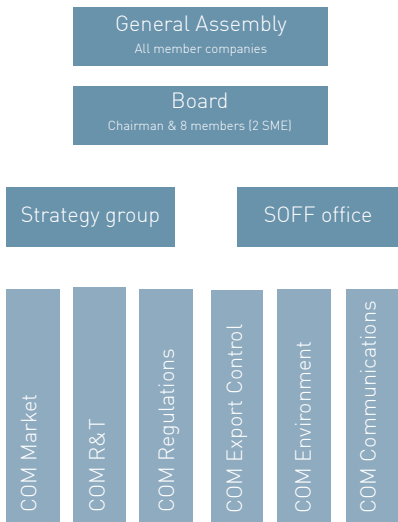
Marketing activities: Country exchange seminars and conferences in cooperation with NDIAs in relevant countries. SOFF also arranges joint pavilions at international defence and security exhibition for interested members.

Member Services: General business related advice is regularly provided to members and relevant educational seminars are recurrently arranged.

Facts

SOFF Organisation

The SOFF office coordinates the activities of the Association and is governed by a board consisting of representatives from the industries. The member companies nominate representatives to participate in the Association's strategy group and commissions. Except for all commission-related meetings, conferences and education, the Association arranges one General Assembly in May and one Annual Meeting in the autumn for all members, where relevant issues such as market trends are discussed.



NOTE: In addition to the bodies described in the organization chart above, SOFF also has a number of "groups of interest" on various themes chosen by the members.

Facts

The following is a short description of the responsibilities of the strategy group and commissions (Com) that operate within the Association:

- Strategy group - Observe medium and long-term trends for issues related to security and defence with a particular emphasis on the defence industry. The strategy group has an overarching responsibility for the commissions which serve as expert groups for the Strategy group.
- Com Market - Observe trends in defence markets in Sweden and internationally. Works with issues related to market access and interacts frequently with government agencies.
- Com R&T - Active in the debate relating to the need and intensity of research and technology development in both a Swedish and a European perspective.
- Com Regulations - Manage and follow-up issues relating to legislation, regulations and guidelines for the sector.
- Com Export Control - Manage and follow-up issues relating to implementation of more stringent export control laws and issues related to arms exports.
- Com Environment - Deals with issues related to environmental regulations. It interacts frequently with the Swedish Armed Forces and other government agencies.
- Com Communication - Consists predominately of information directors from the member companies and deals with issues related to public affairs and communication.

Facts

The Security and Defence Market

The apprehension of security has changed drastically over the last decades. Major confrontations between great powers are no longer the only security concern. Rather, new and more unforeseeable risks such as regional and ethnic conflicts, natural disasters, organized crime, pandemics, climate change and different types of terrorist actions are also at the centre of attention. Military threats are part of a wider risk management spectrum. The increased interdependence brought about by the globalization process has eroded the lines between national and international security. Distant threats and risks might be as much a concern as those that are near at hand. Thus the first line of defence is often abroad.

Peace support missions and the impact of terrorism have also led to obscure lines between military and civil security stressing a need for better co-ordination between both. It is becoming increasingly evident that civilian and military technologies overlap. Common technologies can often be used for both military and civilian applications in areas such as computers, command & control, wired and wireless communications and sensors.



Facts

According to guidelines from the Swedish parliament, Sweden shall endeavor to participate in international cooperation in order to allow cost sharing and interoperability. Export successes have contributed to the industry being perceived as an attractive partner in international co-operation programmes. This strengthens the industry's position in an international network of defence industries, which is a basis for establishing long term relationships and increased security of supply. Exports of defence products and services also contribute to keeping up the domestic industrial competence and capacity to maintain, develop and adapt the equipment of the Swedish Armed Forces.

The Swedish Security and Defence Industry Association thus consist of large as well as small and medium sized (SME) companies. The mission is to improve the market conditions for all of the members. The planning for promotion of SME companies includes activities to support the SME companies to achieve better market access. The activities also take into account that SME companies vary significantly between themselves. The SMEs work as producers of end-user products. They are innovators of new technology and new products, quite often as spin-off companies from academia or larger companies. They can be subcontractors and they can be providers of different types of services. What they have in common is basically their size. Being a member of the Swedish Security and Defence Industry Association strengthens their network, connections and knowledge; excellent tools for business.

International Co-operations

AeroSpace and Defence Industries Association of Europe

The Swedish Security and Defence Industry Association is a member of the AeroSpace and Defence Industries Association of Europe (ASD). ASD represents the aeronautics, space, defence and security industries in Europe in all matters of common interest, with the objective of promoting and supporting the competitive development of the sector. ASD pursues joint industry actions which require management on a European level or which concern issues of an agreed transnational nature, and generate common industry positions.



ASD represents 16 major European aerospace and defence companies as well as 27 member associations in 20 countries across Europe. It also represents over 2,000 companies with a further 80,000 suppliers, many of which are SMEs. The industry sectors employ around 752.000 people, with a turnover of over €186.8 billion. The ASD Secretariat is based in Brussels.

European Defence Equipment Market

The reformation of the market for defence material and sensitive equipment (civil security) is related to the "Defence package": A strategy for a stronger and more competitive defence industry in Europe; Directives for defence and sensitive procurement and for Intra Community Transfer of defence components and systems. The directives have been transposed to national law in Sweden as well as other EU member states. The Swedish Security and Defence Industry Association are taking active part in the implementation and have been doing so throughout the process in EU which has been running for several years. As the Swedish defence and security industry is most competitive and genuinely dependant on the export market, the Swedish Security and Defence Industry Association is, domestically and internationally, fighting for a truthfully open European defence market on an actually levelled playing field; characterized by fair play.

Facts

The European Aerospace and Defence Industry initiative for Anti-corruption and Ethics

For becoming a member of the Swedish Security and Defence Industry Association, all members are required to comply with ADS:s Common Industry Standards (CIS) for anticorruption, which are regarded as important aspects of the notion of a level playing field and cover the following aims:

- to promote the prevention of corruption in the international aerospace and defence market,
- to encourage the adoption of corporate policies and practices which are intended not only to achieve compliance with applicable laws but also to exceed this standard by the implementation of recognised best practice,
- to promote the adoption of the standard as the norm by its members,
- to share good practice and available documentation/information among members, and particularly those members with restricted availability of expert resources, in order to encourage and assist the mutual raising of standards and to allow further improvements and strengthening of the standard,
- to gain acceptance by external stakeholders of the effort and intent of its members in relation to the prevention of corruption in the international aerospace and defence market.

Framework Agreement - Six-Nation Initiative – Letter of Intent (LoI)

In July 2000, the six large defence industrial nations of Europe – the United Kingdom, Germany, France, Italy, Spain and Sweden – signed an important defence industry co-operation agreement on a government level, the Framework Agreement. This agreement was a result of the Six-Nation Initiative; a joint statement adopted by the countries' ministers of defence in 1998, on measures to facilitate the restructuring of the European defence industry.

The national industrial qualities and capacities are decisive for membership and the purpose of the agreement is to facilitate

harmonisation of military requirements and the creation of cooperative projects and procurements.

The topics involved are thus: Harmonisation of military equipment requirements, Security of supply, export procedures, Security of information, Research and technology, Treatment of technical information.

European Defence Agency

On July 12, 2004, the EU Council of Ministers decided to establish the European Defence Agency (EDA). Sweden participates in the EDA,



which has the following main tasks:

- To support the member nations' efforts to develop the Common Security and Defence Policy (CSDP),
- To propose and support European collaborative projects,
- To reinforce the European Defence Technology and Industrial Base (EDTIB) with the aim of creating an international competitive European market for military equipment,
- To promote co-operation and efficiency in European defence research, development and technology.

The EDA has a board consisting of the defence ministers of each participating member state and a representative of the EU Commission. This board is the EDA's decision-making body. Unlike most international organizations, involved in defence cooperation, decisions are made by qualified majority. Votes are counted in the same way as in corresponding systems in the EU.

NORDEFCO - Nordic Defence Co-operation



Nordic defence cooperation has a long tradition. The Nordic Armed Forces are based on similar fundamentals in terms of tasks, objectives and concepts, making broad cooperation both possible and preferable. The cooperation is based on the conviction that there is much to be gained through shared experiences, cost sharing, joint solutions and joint actions.

The current Nordic defence cooperation is, after the signing of the Memorandum of Understanding from 2009, known as NORDEFCO (Nordic Defence Co-operation). It is impossible for the participants to choose which projects they want to share. This means that much of the cooperation is as likely to be carried out bi- or trilaterally.

Joint Nordic Defence Industry Cooperation Group

In addition to NORDEFCO the Nordic Defence Industry Associations signed a MoU in November 2012 in order to establish the Joint Nordic Defence Industry Cooperation Group (JNDICG). The intention of the MoU is to support the Nordic armed forces to develop and sustain military capabilities in those areas where the Nordic defence industry has state-of-the-art technology and competence.

NATO/NIAG Co-operation

The Swedish Security and Defence Industry Association represents the Swedish Security and Defence Industry in NIAG/PfP (NATO Industrial Advisory Group/Partnership for Peace).

Facts

Transatlantic Co-operation

For many years Sweden has established a close and fruitful cooperation with the USA. In addition to the bilateral Memorandum of Understanding MoU, a Declaration of Principles DoP has been signed.

The DoP covers the following areas:

- Harmonization of military requirements and acquisition processes
- Research and development
- Meeting security of supply requirements
- Security of Information
- Ownership and corporate governance
- Technical information
- Promoting defence trade

US technology constitutes the base of many Swedish products, especially within the aerospace industry. The US market is extremely important for numerous Swedish companies who are key suppliers to the US.

Furthermore the Office for Defence Industry Cooperation at the Swedish embassy in Washington provides important networks and advices to Swedish companies that would like to promote their products on the US market. The office consists of representatives from the industry and is in part financed by SOFF.

The Swedish Security and Defence Industry Association and the US counterpart National Defence Industry Association (NDIA) signed a MoU in 2009, which relates to their cooperation, including industrial conferences and meetings covering important European and Transatlantic issues. These conferences are arranged in co-operation with the US and the Swedish Governments under the bilateral MoU between Sweden and the USA. These interactions are being intensified and have promoted extended cooperation between the US and Swedish companies of all sizes.

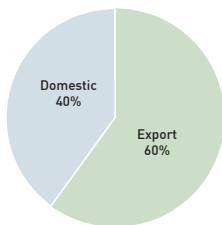
Statistics

The total turnover

The total turnover of the member companies' security and defence related sales amounted to approximately 30 billion SEK in 2013.

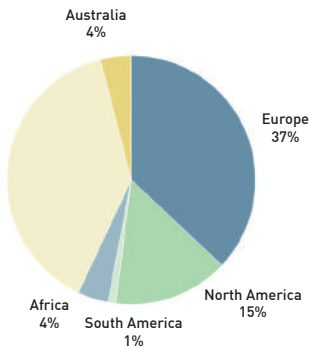
Distribution of sales divided by export and domestic

Compared to 2012 the export share of total sales has decreased slightly while domestic sales increased with approximately 5 percent. It should also be noted that a considerable share of sales in Sweden are intra-industry sales particular from SME:s to lead system integration companies to enable export rather than sales to the Swedish government. Consequently access to international markets has become increasingly important for the Swedish security and defence industrial base.



Distributions of exports among continents

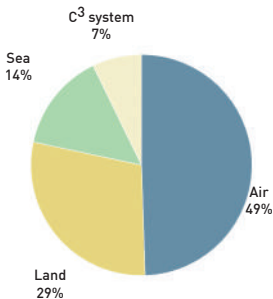
Europe and Asia constitute the most important destinations collectively receiving more than 70 percent of all exports. Export to Asia has increased slightly since 2012 while export to Europe has fallen during the last year due to austerity measures and falling defence expenditures. During 2013 export to North America also increased notably compared to last year.

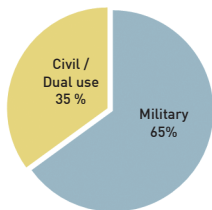
The turnover for all military products in different domains

Over the years the defence industry, together with the Armed Forces and the Swedish Defence Material Administration performed a number of successful developments. Thus today's export success is the result of previous long-term investments. As a consequence Sweden has been able to establish a unique security and defence industrial base, broad enough to cover system platforms in all domains such as fighter aircrafts, naval surface vessels, submarines and land platforms.



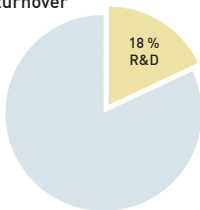
Military and Civilian/Dual Use sales

Civil security and dual use products have steadily increased as shares of total sales for the Swedish security and defence industry. In part this reflects the changing nature of the security environment since the terrorist attacks in the United States on 11th September 2001. In order to reduce the challenges associated with decreasing defence expenditures in Europe several companies have deliberately broaden their product portfolio in order to expand market shares within the civilian security sector.



Research and Development as shares of turnover

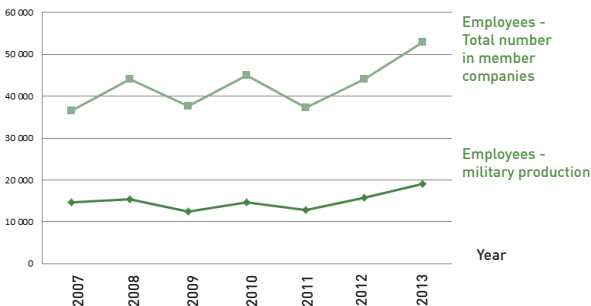
The Swedish security and defence industrial base is exceptionally research intensive. The Saab Group which is by far the biggest member of SOFF devotes 25 percent of its turnover to research and development (R&D). On average R&D constitute approximately 18 percent of total the turnover that the industry generates.
